Periods Ended September 30, 1995 Through 2005

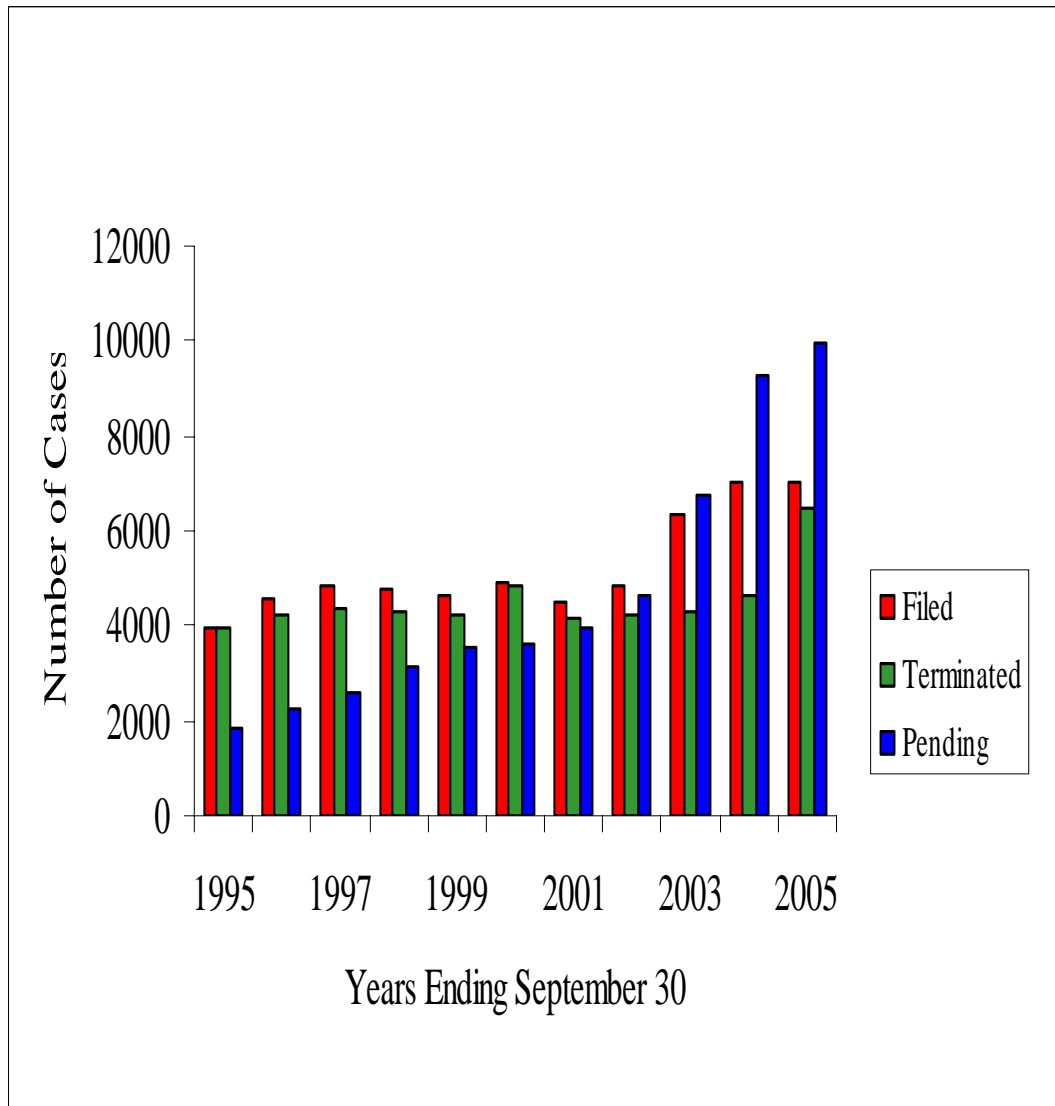

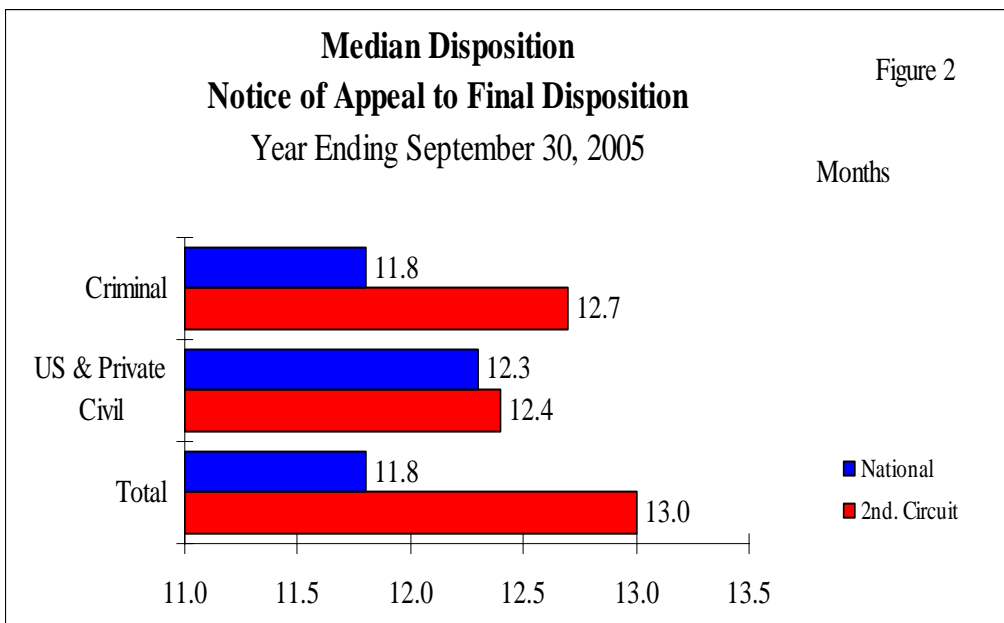

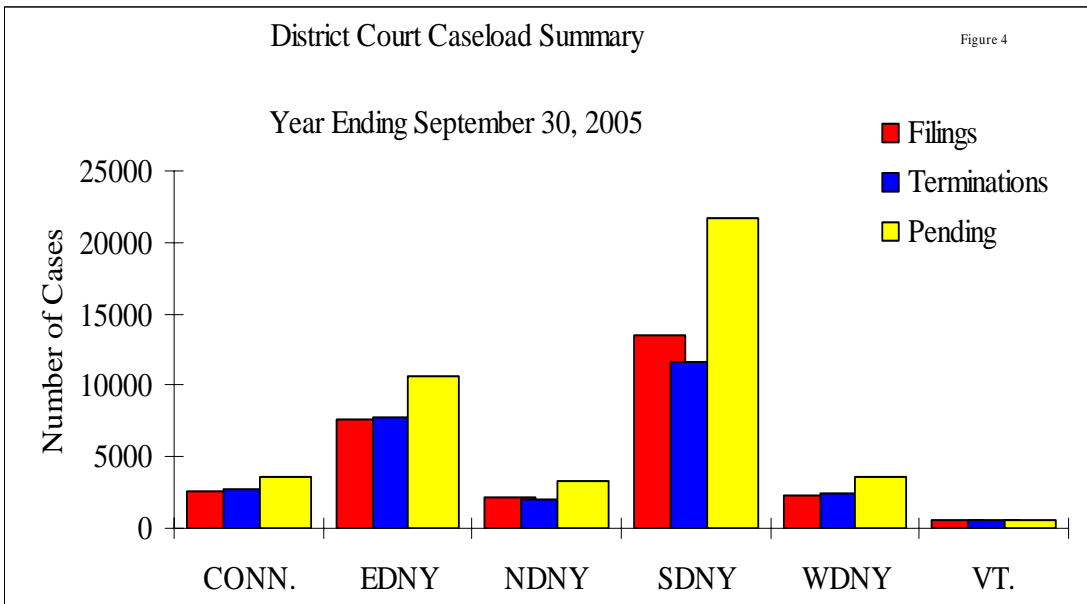

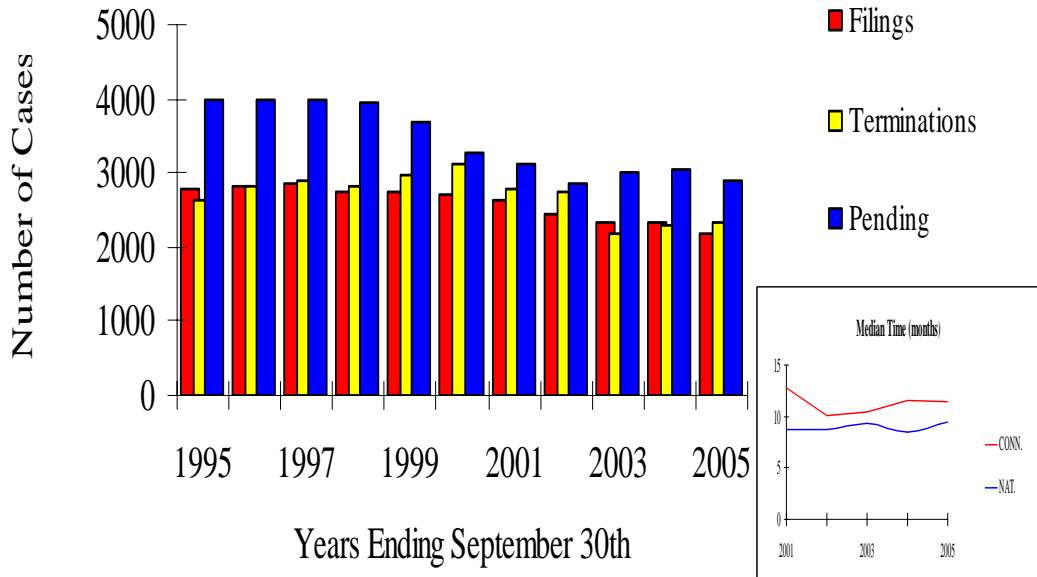

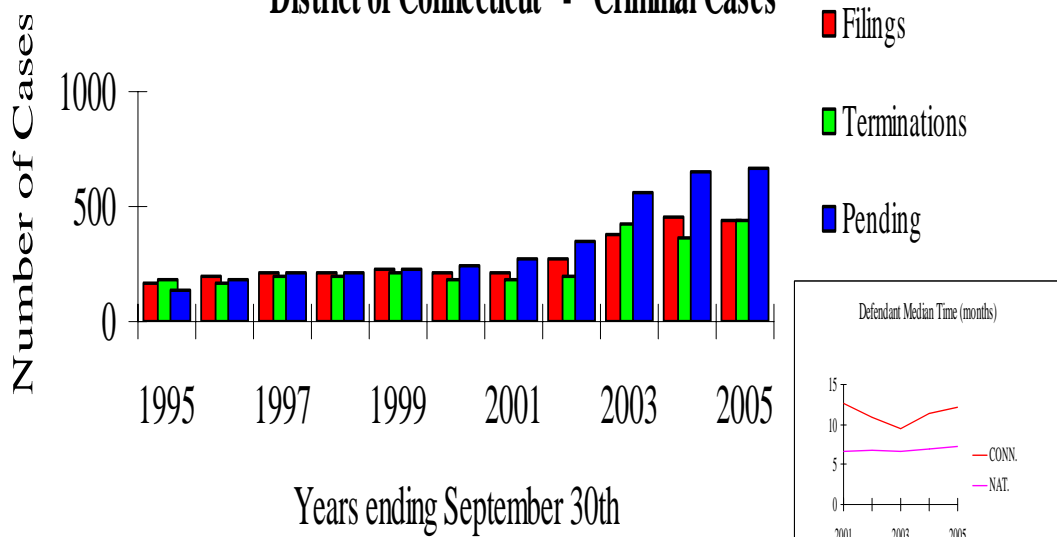
District of Connecticut - Civil Cases

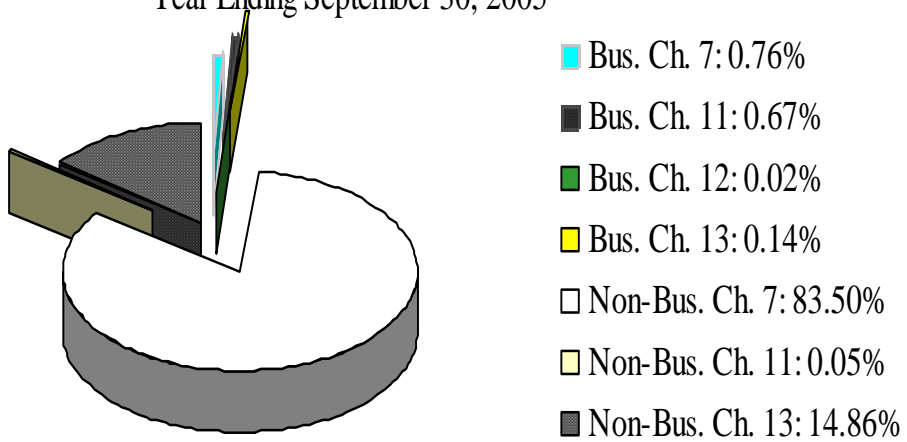

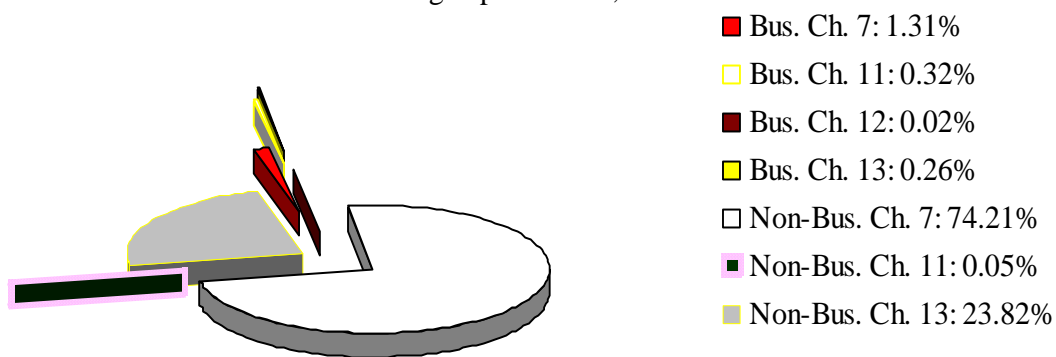

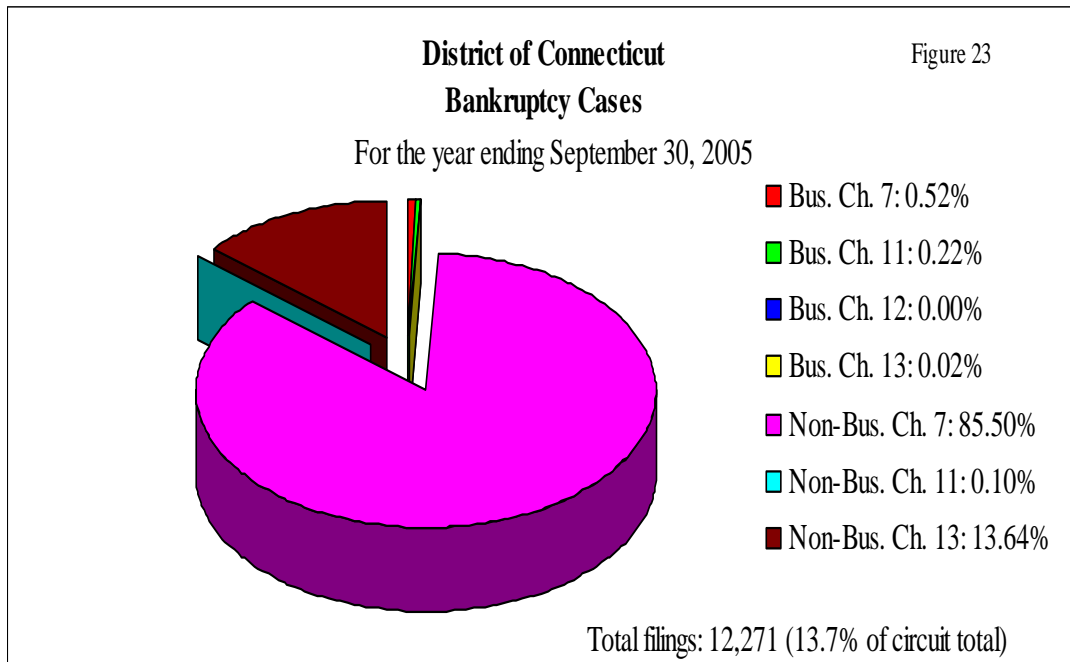

For the Year Ending September 30, 2005

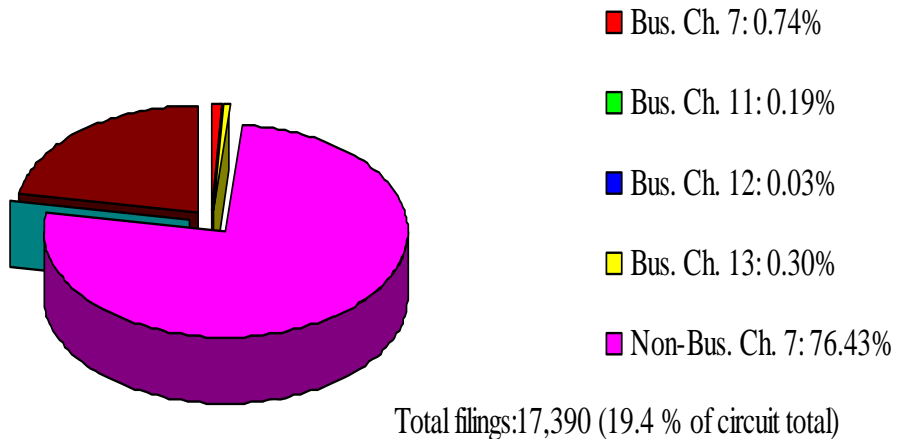

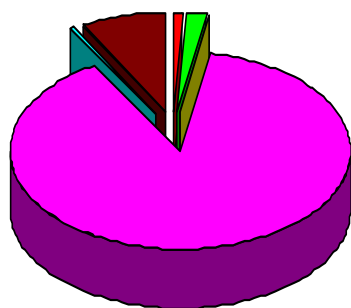
